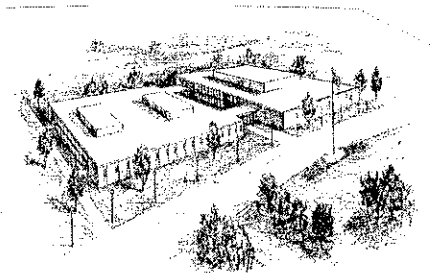

Re: 2016-17 Information and Reports

The 2011 legislative session made some changes to how Home Schools report. A **Full Report** was required the first year of the new legislation, 2011-12. The following years will only require a **Letter of Intent to Continue Homeschooling, which is enclosed in this mailing.**

Also find enclosed the following information from the Department of Education pertaining to Home Schooling:

- 1) Request Form for Textbooks, Standardized Test and Individual Instructional Materials
- 2) Request Form for District Pupil Health Services
- 3) Request Form for District Secondary Guidance/Counseling Services
- 4) Student Report for Aids to Nonpublic Students

You must fill out items 1-3 for each student that you home school, item #4 is a summary of items 1-3 and requires your signature at the bottom. You should have received a copy of the **“Nonpublic Fall Report 2016-17”** from the Minnesota Department of Education. Please return one copy of this report when you return your other information to the school.

You will also find a memo pertaining to students with disabilities and memorandum from the Department of Education.

If there are any classes that you would like your child to take at the public school, please contact me about this.
