

First Grade Snow Day BINGO

- This year some of our snow days will be counted as virtual learning days in place of making up snow days. Each virtual learning day your student will be expected to complete a “BINGO” on their BINGO card (on the back) by completing an activity from each column. Students may earn a BINGO **across only**. We will use the same BINGO card for each virtual learning day. Students need to complete a different BINGO for each virtual learning day.
- **PLEASE KEEP THIS CARD IN A SAFE PLACE. IT WILL BE USED FOR UP TO 5 VIRTUAL LEARNING DAYS.**
- **Parents:** Please sign off on each activity your child completes.
- **Students:** Please choose one color to color your BINGO row, and color lightly so we can see your data you have provided.
- All students need to complete a BINGO on each virtual learning day. Students that do not complete a BINGO at home or have the space signed, will be required to complete it at school during recess or free time.
- Your child’s teacher will be available to answer questions by email during school hours.
- Please bring the completed BINGO board and activities back to school on the next school day.
